a) General Update

There are 8 names on the waiting list for this site with the first waiting since July 2018: there are no vacant plots at present.

b) Other Site Business

1. It was mentioned that there is a sign in the notice board with a contact number offering a half plot. The Clerk pointed out that it cannot be an officially vacant plot and those present agreed that it is probably an existing tenant looking for some help with their plot.

2. The site representatives had walked round the site and found most plots generally in good order. One plot that had been of concern was now being worked and was 50% cleared.

3. Sheep had been escaping into the site from the neighbouring field; tenants had managed to shepherd them back into their field and patch the hole in the fence.

4. Barry mentioned that some road planings would be useful for patching pot holes; the Clerk had been trying without success for some time to get some for Eliff's Mill but would keep chasing SBC to remind them.
